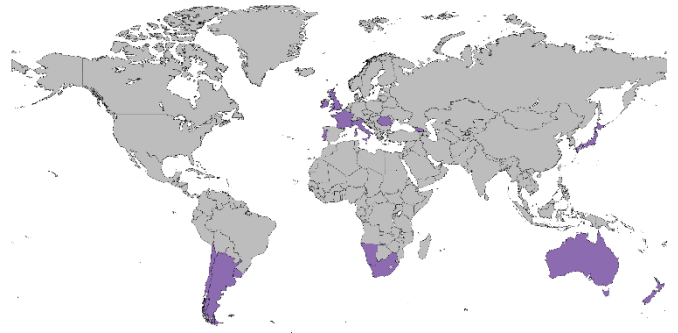
Indeed, French taxation applies to sportmen playing in France even if they are non French resident for tax purposes.
