

# Eco-contributions: all your obligations!

If your company manufactures products sold on the French market, you should be concerned by one of the 20 extended producer responsibility (EPR) sectors.

**Are you concerned ? What are your obligations ?  
What are the penalties in case of failure ?**

## YOUR CHALLENGES

French and foreign « manufacturers » of waste-generating products have to fulfill several obligations:

- Adhesion to an eco-organism
- Obtention of a unique ID
- Preparation of a preventive and eco-concepted plan
- Annual declaration of the products released for consumption
- Payment of eco-contributions to eco-organisms
- Indication of signage and sorting instructions on the products (Triman's logo)
- Information of the customers concerning the environmental characteristics of certain products

A manufacturer failing to fulfill its obligations incurs a fine of up to € 7 500 per unity (i.e. per product) or ton of products released for consumption
